#### Selection of Consultancy firm/s for Conducting Annual Outcome Surveys of projects which have been implemented by Small Holder Agribusiness Program (SAPP)

Smallholder Agribusiness Partnership (SAPP) Programme is jointly funded by the Government of Sri Lanka (GOSL) and the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD). The SAPP has been designed to contribute to Sri Lanka's smallholders' poverty reduction and competitiveness. The programme development objective is to sustainably increase the income and quality of diet of 57,500 smallholder households involved in commercially oriented production and marketing systems. The SAPP programme is instrumental to achieve GOSL priorities under the national policy framework on rural development through Public- Private-Producer-Partnerships (4Ps).

#### The Scope and Objective of the Assignment

The overall purpose of this assignment is to assess the progress achieved in respective project outcome against the project interventions and provide quantitative and qualitative interpretations on specific outcome indicators as reflected in the project M & E framework against baseline information and provide suggestions to the SAPP to improve program's support to achieve targeted outcomes during the project implementation.

Interested Consultants/ Consultancy Firms must provide information indicating interested projects and that they are qualified to perform the services in respect of projects indicated. 1. Business registration evidence
2. Experience of the firm
3. Experience of the firm in dealing with similar assignments (i.e. completion of Baseline Studies)
4. Team composition of the firm (at present)
