Smallholder Agribusiness Partnership Program (SAPP) is implemented under the Ministry of Agriculture and it has been jointly funded by the Government of Sri Lanka and the International Fund for Agricultural Development (IFAD). The SAPP is designed to contribute Sri Lanka's smallholders' poverty reduction and competitiveness. The program development objective is to sustainably increase the income and quality of diet of 57,500 smallholder households involved in commercially-oriented production and marketing systems. The SAPP program is instrumental to achieve GOSL priorities under the national policy framework on rural development through Public, Private, Producer Partnerships (4Ps).

We call proposals from the qualified firms to select as a consultant to design, develop, install and maintain a **Management Information System** of the program/project (SAPP). The following qualifications and experience are required to apply for the assignment and qualified firm will be selected under QCBS (Quality and Cost Based Selection) as defined in the RFP document.

Qualifications and Experience required

- I. The firm should have consisted minimum 4 consultants preferably the lead consultant which may be an IT specialist, Software Engineer, System Analyze cum Programmer (System Engineer), GIS expert/ Programmer.
- II. The lead consultant should possess minimum of Master degree in Information Technology, field with 10 years post qualification experience, of which preferably in senior management level in the development of MIS of Agriculture and related sector/s.
- III. Extensive experience in carrying out complex field based surveys to collect MIS related data including in implementing agriculture related modules.
- IV. Experience in quantitative data collection, analysis and synthesis and reporting using statistical software.
- V. Capacity to use GIS for mapping purposes.
- VI. Experience in developing mobile applications and computer software for data management.
- VII. Capacity of training of PMU and Field staff whenever necessary
- VIII. Should available for maintaining, training and keep updating the MIS until the programme is phase-out.
- IX. High degree of independence, flexibility and ability to meet strict deadlines.
- X. Excellent communication skills.
